Learning Excursion Committee

- Committee Leads: Meaghan Tullis and Madeleine Nicholls
- Goals
 - Plan world class Learning Excursions and an Insider's Tour that showcases
 Greater Vancouver's industry leading real estate projects. Focusing on unique
 experiences and learning opportunities.

Major Responsibilities:

- Present 15 Learning Excursion options to CREW Network (12 will be selected)
 - Excursions will be 2 3 hours and will showcase best in class examples of placemaking, development and real estate.
- Plan Insider's Tour
 - Will take place on Wednesday September 25 from 11:30 to 4:00 pm
 - Provide an overview and tour of current/future industry projects
 - Estimate 100 participants.
- Major Milestone Dates:
 - **Feb 16, 2024**: List of 15 excursions to be submitted to CREW Network for final selection of 12.
 - March 1, 2024: Budget and logistics detail due to CREW Network for approval

Learning Excursion Committee

- Number of Volunteers:
 - Learning Excursions:
 - 24 volunteers
 - minimum 2 volunteers per Excursion with 4 excursions per day over 3 days
 - Insider's Tour:
 - 2 to 4 volunteers for 100 participants
- Type of roles required:
 - Volunteer Point Person for each Excursion: confirm speakers, develop program content and logistics, prepare any handouts or information for the tour.
 - Excursions Volunteers (day of): volunteers required to direct participants, provide additional information on tours and execute itinerary prepared
 - Insider's Tour Volunteers: generate detailed itinerary, confirm speakers, develop program content, compile handouts, direct participants; required to be available for tour on September 25th

Sponsorship Committee

- Committee Leads: Shanon Thornley and Larissa Jacobson-Rooke
- Goals and responsibilities of Committee: responsible for raising approximately \$150,000 USD as a target
- Major Milestone Dates: May confirmation for finalization of funds
- Number of Volunteers: 2
- Type of roles required:
 - Coordinating sponsorships
 - Reaching out to potential sponsors
 - Track and confirm commitments

Hospitality & Leisure Committee

- Committee Lead: Elaine Chong
- Goals and responsibilities of Committee:
 - Staff the Hospitality Table at the Convention
 - Lead the Netwalk, Netrun and Yoga
- Major Milestone Dates:
 - Mostly day-of responsibilities
 - Research giveaways
 - Yoga instructor recommendation
- Number of Volunteers: 14+





Hospitality & Leisure Committee

- Type of roles required:
- Convention Hosts to staff the hospitality table during registration hours
 - 2+ volunteers all day Wednesday
 - 2+ volunteers all day Thursday
 - 2+ volunteers all day Friday
- Hospitality table is to provide information for Dine Around, sightseeing, local attractions, shopping, restaurants and maps if available
- Volunteers to research giveaways





Hospitality & Leisure Committee

- Type of roles required:
- NetWalk Hosts to plan and lead walk (~4 km)
- NetRun Hosts to plan and lead run (~4 km)
 - Scheduled for Thursday and Friday mornings from 6 am and ending no later than 7 am
 - Yoga offered on Friday only






Dine Around Committee

- Goals and responsibilities of Committee: coordinate and host approximately 15 - 20+ small group dinners
- Major Milestone Dates:
 - July 1, 2024: Dine Around Templates (reservation confirmed) to CREW Network for Approval
 - July 28, 2024: Dine Around Sign-Up Form & Link to CREW
 Network
 - Sept 26 & 27, 2024: Dine Arounds!
- Number of Volunteers: 20 25

Dine Around Committee

- Type of roles required:
 - Dine Around Coordinators: Liaise with local restaurants and secure reservations, ensure each event has a Host & Back Up Host (2 5 volunteers): 5+ hours, between Spring September
 - Dine Around Host / Back Up Host: Act as hosts or back up hosts for each dinner event (2 people assigned to each dinner): 3–4 hours on Sep 26 / 27
- There may be multiple tables sat at any one restaurant, but no group should be larger than 8 12 people at one table, with 1 2 CREW Vancouver "Hosts" at each table
- Registration can happen online prior to Convention and onsite via sign-up sheets at Hospitality table

- Committee Lead: Tina Lu
- Goals and responsibilities of Committee: promote the convention to the local Vancouver industry; raise awareness through local media and PR activities
- Major Milestone Dates: target for 75% participation from local Chapter
- Number of Volunteers: 2-3
- Type of roles required:
 - Liaise with the CREW Vancouver Marcom Committee
 - Create graphics and marketing materials
 - Provide information to local media and other local real estate groups
 - Lead and coordinate all PR activities
